Members who would find it financially difficult to purchase concert dress should inform their section leader, who will bring their concern to the attention of the Artistic Director. Assistance will be provided.

EUGENE CONCERT CHOIR – Concert Dress

Female: Three choices of concert dress are ordered through the choir and must be purchased by members:

- 1) Black and white full-length dress
- 2) Separates – black top with white insert and long black skirt
- 3) Separates – black top with white insert and palazzo pants

Cost for dress or separates has been \$90. We don't know yet if current price has increased.

Black dress shoes. Minimal jewelry that does not cross the line of the dress or top is optional.

Male: Members are responsible for providing their own black tuxedo of any style, white wing-collar shirt, black bow tie and black dress shoes; black cummerbunds are optional. We have options to order tuxedos, shirts and bow ties through choir apparel companies as well. Contact the choir office if you would like to order a tuxedo.

Non-binary: Members may choose to wear whichever concert dress of the above descriptions aligns with their identity.

EUGENE CONCERT CHOIR – Victorian attire, mid 1800s

At times, the choir wears Victorian or “Dickens” attire for a themed holiday concert, such as we have this year. We have some accessories like capes and top hats in our inventory and some costumes as well. Otherwise, members are encouraged to find appropriate attire to create the desired effect. EUGENE VOCAL ARTS – Concert Dress

Concert dresses for women are checked out from the Eugene Concert Choir inventory.

Female: Identical floor-length black and royal blue dresses. Black dress shoes.

Minimal jewelry that does not cross the top line of the dress is optional.

Male: Members are responsible for providing their own black tuxedo of any style, white wing-collar shirt and black dress shoes. We have options to order tuxedos and shirts through choir apparel companies as well. Contact the choir office if you would like to order a tuxedo.

Royal blue vests and bow ties will be checked out through the Choir inventory.

Non-binary: Members may choose to wear whichever concert dress of the above descriptions aligns with their identity.
